# How does our program work?

We train and compete in the official Israel Football League.

Providing professional development with hi-tech courses and internships, hebrew ulpan, motivational talks with renowned coaches and athletes from around the world as well as trips around the country.

We are based in high-end apartments in the center of Tel Aviv, one of the most vibrant and sought after neighborhoods in Israel.

The program is open to men and women ages 18-24

We offer college-level training and provide the experience to connect to the land of Israel and your jewish heritage.

# Israel's Football Semi Pro League

Throughout the program, participants will compete in Israel's Semi Pro Football league.

The winner of each level moves up the next season, while the team with the lowest record at each level gets bumped down.

The top three levels for men are considered to be professional, as players get paid.

Our program is in a sweet spot where we maintain players college eligibility, while offering great exposure to the higher levels, pro coaches and scouts.

League games typically are once a week with at least +25 games in the regular season.

All games will be broadcast live for anyone abroad who wants to join in and are recorded for players future reference and use.






## Tel Aviv “Beit Maccabi”

# Food, housing, transportation and supervision:

Throughout the program, each participant will receive:

- Three meals a day (provided cooked meals, or you may be given money to buy and cook your own food)
- Housing
- All land transportation relevant to the program (Rav Kav bus pass)
- Activities
- Supervision and monitoring through our staff
- All weekends are included in the program



## Medical Insurance:

Participants have medical coverage throughout their entire program participation, from the moment they begin the program until the day it ends.

This coverage does **NOT** cover dental services, psychological therapy, or physiotherapy treatments.



# Registration

The following points are mandatory requirements for participation in the program:

Each participant must complete their registration form with the exact program dates, NOT the dates of arrival in Israel or return to their home country.

Each participant receives a symbolic scholarship of \$200 USD.

# VISA



All visitors to Israel have the right to stay up to 90 days as a tourist.

Participants in our program are considered students because they are part of a MASA program. And are not subject to the 90 day restriction.

**In order to process the student VISA (A-2), it is ESSENTIAL to complete the application for the MASA scholarship.** Otherwise, you will not obtain student status, so you will not be able to apply for a VISA.

The entire visa process will be handled at the participant's expense. It is their responsibility to have their paperwork in order to participate in the program.

**IT IS ESSENTIAL TO PROCESS THE VISA IN YOUR COUNTRY OF ORIGIN**

**\*Participants with Israeli parents must resolve their immigration status independently before starting the program. They should contact the Israeli consulate/embassy in their home country directly.**

# Program Cancellation

Those who, having started the program, decide to shorten their stay should keep in mind that Masa scholarships are awarded for programs lasting at least four months.

If the program ends voluntarily before the end of the four months, the scholarship will be canceled.

This means that if the participant incurs a debt, the participant will be responsible for paying the remaining amount.

To consider the request for a change, it must be submitted in writing to the responsible management in Israel.

If the program is longer than four months, the scholarship will be determined based on the program duration, with Masa's discretion regarding the amount of the scholarship.

Those who voluntarily wish to cancel their participation in the program before its conclusion must notify Masa at least one month before the start of the corresponding phase. If the cancellation is made two months in advance, the remaining amount of the program will be fully refunded. If you provide one month's notice, 50% of the value will be refunded; otherwise, you will not be entitled to a refund.

# Situation of War Cancellation

Before the program begins, if the participant voluntarily decides to leave Israel:

-The active chapter will not be refunded and will incur an additional charge of \$800 USD for general expenses.

In the event that MWU terminates the program due to war:

-The active chapter will not be refunded.

In the event that housing re-accommodation is necessary due to war, MWU reserves the right to charge up to \$500 USD for the duration of the re-accommodation.

-If the participant decides not to arrive in Israel before the program starts, 100% of the amount paid will be refunded.



# Program Cost



Israel Football Experience 26/27: \$21,000 USD

Payment for the program will depend on the country of origin.

For the United States, Mexico, Colombia, and Guatemala, payment is made directly to Maccabi World Cup via:

- Bank transfer
- Credit card
- Cash in dollars at Maccabi World Cup in Israel.

- Payment by credit card carries a 3.5% fee per charge
- By the start of the program, the full amount of the program must be paid
- Different payment methods are available
- Payment can be made in installments
