DUDE, WHERE'S MY GOALS?



Hi there!

Here is an easy checklist of where to find or set up your goals for your game at Caulfield Park. (Refer to the Caulfield Park fields map for ground numbers.)

Where's my goals?

- U8 U9 teams play on the Mini Fields. They use the permanent 3 metre goals.
- If your team is allocated to field 3, X or Y, then nets will need to be put up on the permanent goals. All nets and tools will be in appropriately marked wheelie bins outside the centre grey brick pavilion (the bunker).
- Goals must be set up at least 15 minutes prior to your team's game kick off time.
- All goals nets and tools must be returned and placed in the wheelie bins and delivered to the bunker at the end of the game, unless there is a game following yours. Check the ground allocations prior.
- All U10 U13 teams will be playing on field 6, this is a new trial for this year. Field 6
 will be marked into half fields, so that you can use one of the two 5 metre goals that
 we have.
- The 5 metre goals for this field are located in the garage at the big pavilion, these goals are to be setup by the first teams of the day and returned to the garage by the last teams of the day. This also includes the sandbags that are in the wheelie cart.
- Flags can be found at the centre grey brick pavilion (the bunker) and must be returned by the last teams, who also return the goals.
- U14 U18 teams; If your team is allocated to field 4 or 5, then nets will need to be
 put up on the permanent goals. All nets and tools will be in appropriately marked
 wheelie bins outside the centre grey brick pavilion (the bunker).
- Goals must be set up at least 15 minutes prior to your team's game kick off time.
- All goals nets and tools must be returned and placed in the wheelie bins and delivered to the bunker at the end of the game, unless there is a game following yours. Please check the ground allocations prior to your game start time.
- In some cases when you arrive at your game your nets will have been set up by previous parents. Your team may need to Disassemble them and return them after your game.
- Check the match day ground allocation list to see if your team needs
 to put nets up or down on the day. This list is sent to every Team
 Manager prior to the weekend. It can also be found on Team App.
- For parents that have done all of this before, you can help out the first timers.
 With a smile of course!

Don't forget that NO PEGS are allowed on field 5, 6 or 7.
